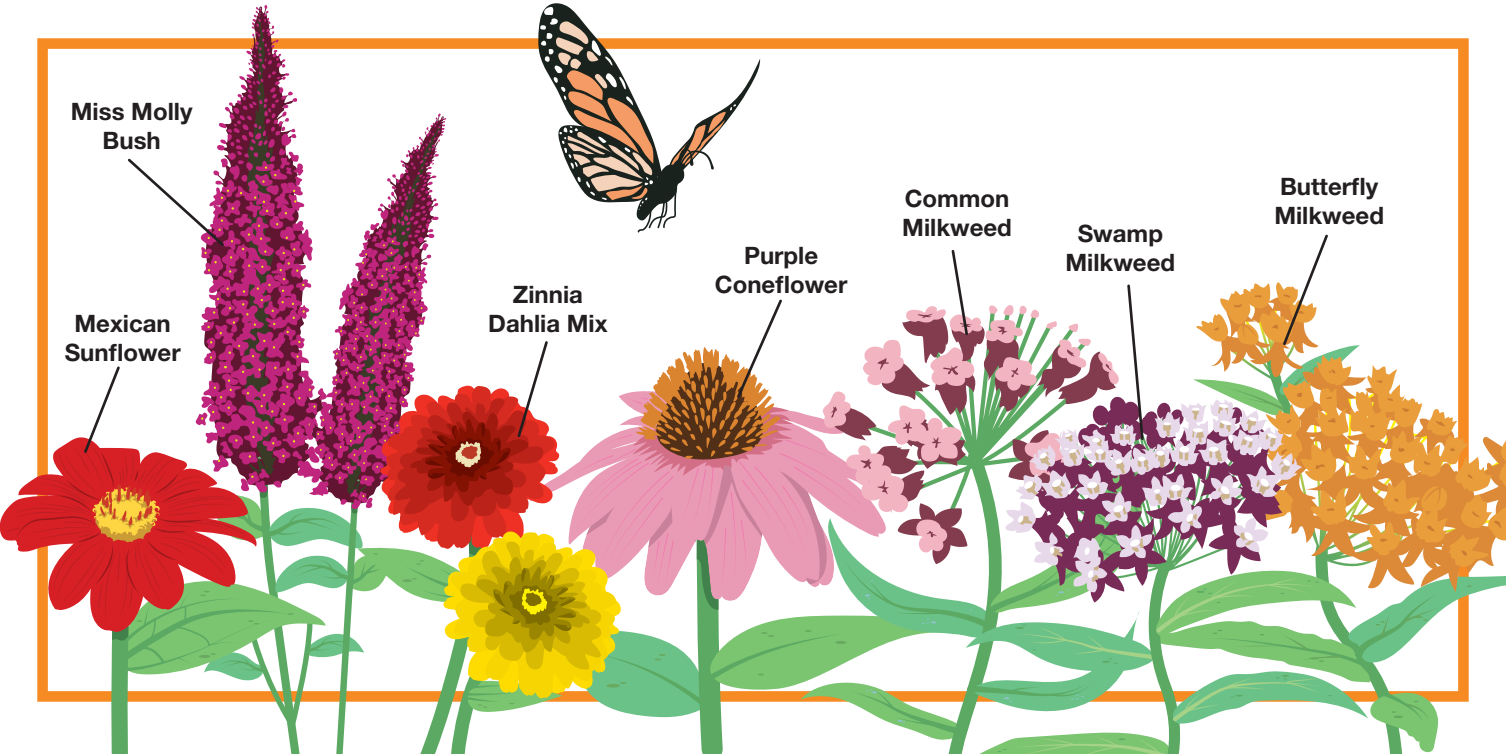

# Nectar Plants

Throughout the lifecycle of a monarch butterfly there are many different types of plants & flowers that help nourish and give homes to these beautiful creatures. These include: Zinnia, Miss Molly Bush, the Mexican Sunflower, to only name a few. Once in adulthood, monarchs then feed on the nectar of these flowering plants, thus pollinating different types of flowers in turn. However, only Milkweed nourishes them during the larvae stage.
